The Special Members Fund is independent from other Snowsport Scotland reserves but is controlled by the Board of Directors. It was agreed that the original capital should be retained and only the interest should be available for projects put forward by the membership (Clubs) or for use as an underwriting fund. This was to prevent it being absorbed into general cash flow or administration of the organisation.

As is the case with other such grants the use of the funds should principally be for the benefit of the members as a whole and therefore any proposals should not be exclusive but for the greater good of our members. The Special Members Fund is currently limited to a maximum of £5,000 for any award.
