

The following terms and conditions apply to all Snowsport Scotland courses. Snowsport Scotland strongly recommends that all candidates take out insurance that includes cancellation and curtailment to cover all unforeseen candidates.

### **Booking Terms and Conditions**

1. Terms and conditions are accepted by the candidate on completion of the booking form.
2. All candidates must be 16 at the start of the L1 Instructor course and 18 for all other courses. If you are under 18 years old the course booking form must be signed by a parent/guardian.
3. Candidates must be a member of the Snowsport Scotland Coaching Scheme prior to booking onto a course. Any candidate who is not a member will have the appropriate membership fee added to the course fee. **If the course is not due to take place until the next membership year, membership for this year will also be added to the course fee if the membership has not yet been paid. This does not apply to direct debit payers.**
4. A place on your chosen course will be booked on receipt of a completed booking form and appropriate fee. All course fees are non-refundable.
5. Deposit is £150 for any course, and payment of the full course fee is due 6 weeks prior to the start of the course.
6. If payment is coming from a third party (such as local authority, or school) a purchase order must be included with the booking form. This will be accepted as payment for the course.
7. Snowsport Scotland reserves the right to cancel courses at any time prior to the course date. In this eventuality Snowsport Scotland will refund all course fees only. Candidates should have insurance including cancellation and curtailment to cover their own expenses incurred.
8. In the event of your booking form being received and Snowsport Scotland cancelling the course, all course fees are either refundable or transferrable.
9. Should a candidate withdraw from a course during or prior to the start of the event due to injury, course fees are transferrable to a course at a later date only on production of a medical certificate. Fees are not refundable.
10. Snowsport Scotland reserves the right to remove you from the course if:
  - a. You are under the influence of alcohol or drugs during course contact time
  - b. You exhibit inappropriate behaviour, at the discretion of the course tutor
11. Snowsport Scotland are not liable for any physical or financial hardships incurred by candidates on the course.
12. All candidates must have personal travel insurance for the duration of the course.
13. You agree, that except for death or personal injury due to negligence of Snowsport Scotland, Snowsport Scotland shall not be liable for any loss or damage arising whether in respect of death, bodily injury, illness suffered or loss, costs or damages or expenses incurred.
14. Snowsport Scotland tutors reserve the right to limit or change day to day activities in the instance of conditions such as bad weather.
