

The following terms and conditions apply to all members and prospective members that register for the Snowsport Scotland Coaching Scheme.

Membership Terms and Conditions

1. Membership Terms and Conditions are accepted by the prospective member on completion of the Coaching Scheme Registration Form.
2. As a member of the Coaching Scheme the member agrees to abide by Snowsport Scotland's code of ethics as viewable on our website www.snowsportsotland.org
 - a. Snowsport Scotland reserves the right to cancel a member's membership if the code of ethics are not adhered to.
3. The membership year ends on 30 September each year. Members are responsible for ensuring that they have paid their subscriptions by this date. If member has not paid by this date they are not insured to use their qualifications.
4. Member is responsible for insuring their qualification is up-to-date and therefore insured to use their qualification. A members qualification is valid upon the criteria below being met
 - a. Membership has been paid to Snowsport Scotland.
 - b. Member holds a valid first aid certificate (a copy of which must be sent to the Snowsport Scotland office). First Aid certificates must be from a course with a minimum of 12 hours contact time and run by an HSE approved provider. First Aid certificates are valid for 3 years. Members are responsible for ensuring that the course meets requirements. If, in the event of an insurance claim, it turns out that a submitted certificate is not valid, Snowsport Scotland are not held responsible.
 - c. The qualifications held by the member meet Snowsport Scotland's refresher policy.
5. Members are responsible for paying an admin fee of £15 to use any course not run by Snowsport Scotland, a Snowsport Scotland Tutor, or BASI, to refresh their qualification. This course is accepted at the discretion of Snowsport Scotland.
6. Snowsport Scotland is not responsible for ensuring its members are up-to-date. It is the members responsibility to pay membership subscriptions, and attend courses, as necessary.
7. If a member cancels their membership no refund is given for the remainder of the membership year still outstanding.
8. Members are responsible for ensuring Snowsport Scotland has up-to-date contact information.
