

Scottish Alpine FIS Races - Wednesday - 6th April 2011 - Courchevel

On the 2nd day of racing the weather was once again in our favour. Many race pistes are suffering at this time of year however the Courchevel Stade was 'setting up' overnight providing fantastic racing once again.

The men were on the Giant Slalom piste again today with Scott McBain, Glasgow Ski Racing, taking the Scottish overall gold followed by Lewis John Scottish Ski Club in silver who also won the Scottish Junior category. Cammy Gunn took away the Scottish overall bronze as well as the Scottish Junior silver and with Scott McWhirter taking away the junior bronze the Scottish men has a great showing.

The women's Slalom produced a challenging morning with a number of abandonments however Kate Angus, Gordon Skiers, had a good day taking both the overall and the junior golds with Cara Brown doing the same with the silver.

The men's international FIS field saw Sebastiano Gastadi (ARG) take gold in the Giant Slalom FIS race today as he did yesterday, with Danielle Sorio (ITA) taking the silver followed by Alexandru Barbu (ROU) in bronze. A very strong women's Slalom field today saw Salome Bancora (ARG) better her bronze from yesterday and take the home gold just managing to beating her fellow Argentinian Juiletta Quiroga into silver position and Giulia Borghetti (ITA) fought off a very competitive field to hold on to bronze.

Thursday and Friday sees the girls take to the Giant Slalom piste and the boys the Slalom for the final two days of the Scottish Alpine Championships and Scottish FIS Races.
