



## Competitor Registration Guidelines 2010/2011

### 1. General Conditions

In order to compete in Snowsport Scotland registered events in Alpine, Freestyle, Grass, Nordic and Speed disciplines all competitors must be registered with Snowsport Scotland.

All competitions are run under FIS rules as varied by Snowsport GB / Snowsport Scotland. Copies of the rules may be purchased from either office & downloaded from the FIS website [www.fis-ski.com](http://www.fis-ski.com). It is the responsibility of the competitor to be conversant with the rules. Your attention is drawn specifically but not exclusively to the regulations governing: safety equipment; commercial markings on equipment and clothing; sponsorship; drug testing and gender verification requirements.

### 2. Club Membership

To compete at events on the Snowsport Scotland calendar all competitors must be current members of a snowsports club affiliated to Snowsport Scotland. This ensures that all competitors have the benefit of insurance cover, mandatory for FIS requirements. Please note that we will check with member clubs to verify all competitors hold current membership. Please provide a signature from the club secretary or other official in Section 4 of the registration form to vouch for your membership & hence insurance cover.

**\*\*Please note that if your address is outside of the UK you must organise your own civil liability insurance\*\***

### 3. Registration Dates

Alpine, Freestyle, Nordic, Speed, Grass, Snowboard

Juniors/Seniors Requiring a FIS Licence	30 July 2010
Re-registrations and others	26 October 2010

Note: After 26 October 2010 re-registration fee for previously registered racers **will be at the higher rate of £45**

### 4. Registration Entitlements

Please select the discipline for which you wish to register and mark this on the application form.

Alpine	Insurance, Events Calendar, Bulletins, Bass Seed Lists on the web and entitlement to compete in events on the Alpine Race Calendar for seed points and in order to obtain artificial seed points
Freestyle	Insurance, Events Calendar, Bulletins and entitlement to compete in events on the Freestyle Race Calendar
Speed & Grass	Insurance, Events Calendar, Bulletins and entitlement to compete in events on the Speed/Grass Race Calendar
Nordic	Insurance, Events Calendar, Bulletins and entitlement to compete in events on the Nordic Race Calendar
Snowboard	Insurance, Events Calendar and Bulletins
Information only	Events Calendar and Bulletins

## Conditions and Regulations

### 5. Alpine Skiing

5.1 Competitions will be run under FIS rules as varied by the organisers.

The following age groups will apply for snow racing in Scotland this season:

Children I	1998 and 1999 DOB	Junior I	1994 – 1995 DOB
Children II	1996 and 1997 DOB	Junior II	1991 – 1993 DOB
		Seniors	1990 DOB and earlier

**Note** Those born in 2000 and younger are eligible to compete in Bairns and Lassies events but are not eligible to register for seed points.

5.2 Racers with seed points from another national seeding system should quote these points and supply the name and address of the agency responsible for the system.

5.3 Only registered racers are eligible to enter Children's, Junior's and Senior's National Circuit races and other seeded events.

5.4 Seed lists are available for downloading from the BritSki website ([www.britski.org](http://www.britski.org)).

5.5 Complete a separate entry form for each Championship and send it with the entry fee to the race Secretary for that Championship. Entries must reach the Race Secretary by noon on the closing date as stated on the events Calendar.

5.6 Entry fees for Snowsport Scotland Alpine races are normally as follows: (check fees on race entry forms) Bairns and Lassies £10, Childrens £40, Seniors £40, Scottish Seniors £60

5.7 Club events will detail costs etc on their individual entry forms.

5.8 By signing the entry form, each competitor (and the parent or guardian if the competitor is under 16 on date of signing) is held to agree to and accept the condition of registration contained in this document.

### 6 Freestyle Skiing

6.1 Competitions will be run under FIS rules as varied by the organisers.

### 7 Speed and Grass Skiing

7.1 Competitions will be run under International rules as varied by the organisers.

### 8 Nordic Skiing

8.1 Competitions will be run under FIS rules as varied by the organisers.

8.2 Before entering, competitors should note which technique is required for each event.

### 9 Snowboard

9.1 Competitions will be run under International rules as varied by the organisers.
