## FIS Licence Application Notes - Alpine

All athletes competing at FIS events must have a FIS licence - If you are unsure whether you require a FIS licence, please discuss it with your coach now.

An early season discount is available until 31<sup>st</sup> July - after this date a higher fee will apply. FIS licences are valid from 1<sup>st</sup> July - 30<sup>th</sup> June each year.

The following notes provide information to assist you in completing the application form. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact us via email. We will always try and answer your enquiry via email but you should add at least two telephone numbers in case we need to contact you.

### Type of Licence

#### ° Full Licence

Full Licences are available to BASS registered competitors born in 1995 or earlier who fulfil the BASS points criteria (see application form). This licence allows you, subject to FIS rules, quotas and British Ski and Snowboard policies, to enter all international FIS alpine competitions.

#### Fee

**£150** Early Season Discount - Available until 31<sup>st</sup> July

**£250** All applications received on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August will be charged this fee

#### ° Limited Licence

Available to BASS registered competitors born in 1995 or earlier. This licence allows you, subject to FIS rules, quotas and British Ski and Snowboard policies, to enter British organised FIS alpine competitions and FIS CIT races.

#### Fee

**£75** Early Season Discount - Available until 31<sup>st</sup> July

**£125** All applications received on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August will be charged this fee

#### ° Upgrading a Limited Licence

At any point during the season a Limited Licence can be upgraded to a Full licence if the BASS point criteria have been met. For more information please contact us via email.

**Name of Clubs:** Please enter the name of the club that you wish to be shown on your listing on the FIS website

## Home Nation Endorsement

Please ensure that you are registered as a competitor / performer with your Home Nation Governing Body (Snowsport England, Snowsport Scotland or Snowsport Wales) for the current season. British Ski and Snowboard will contact your Home Nation Governing Body for confirmation of your registration before issuing your FIS licence.

Home Nation registration only provides third party and civil liability insurance for racers who are resident in the UK. Therefore you must provide proof of your insurance with your FIS licence application form if you reside outside of the UK.

## Declaration

FIS licences can only be issued when a competitor has agreed to adhere to the terms & conditions of the FIS Athlete's Declaration. Ticking the box on the online application will confirm your agreement to the FIS Athlete's Declaration and is your electronic signature. Applicants under the age of 18 must have their application countersigned by their legal guardian.

## Payment

**FIS Licence:** You can send cheques for your licence fee to British Ski and Snowboard, 60 Charlotte Street, W1T 2NU. Cheques should be made payable to British Ski and Snowboard. Alternatively you can tick the box on the application form and provide details of a credit or debit card that is linked to the address of the Licence holder. We will need to call the card holder to get card verification details.

**Race Entry Fee:** Please provide your debit or credit card details on the form. During the season when you submit a request for a race entry, please either contact Kirsty on 0207 842 5764 with your card verification details or include them in your emailed race request. Please do not include any other credit card details on your race entries. Please note the race office will NOT be storing card verification details and you will have to submit them for each race.

Payment for race entries can only be made at the time of a race request. Payments taken for Athletes who subsequently do not get granted a quota spot will be carried forward to their next race entry rather than refunded.
