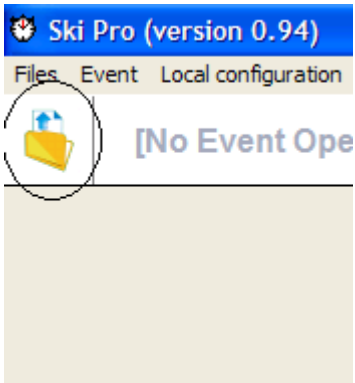
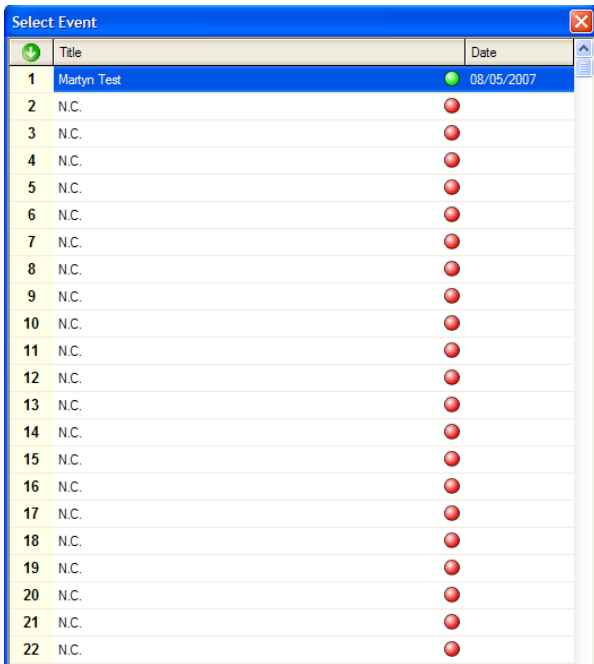


Creating a new event.

To make a new event click here:-

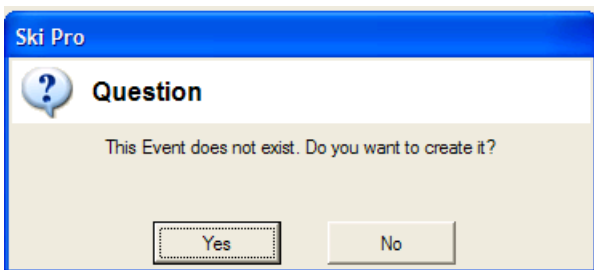


This will bring up this screen:-



This is where you name events etc. This section is similar to the old version of ski.

Select a spare slot (N.C.) then click OK, this will appear:-



Click yes, as you want to create.

The next window to appear is where you actually build your event:-


